The Board is currently looking to fill an upcoming vacancy due to the retirement of long-time staff member Mary Swanek, who has been the Co-ordinator with SouthGrow since its beginning in 2004.

"We have to be very diligent to quickly secure a high-quality and effective person in this vital role. This will be our first priority." said Chairperson Ron Lagemaat. "Mary was a huge part of keeping the wheels of our organization turning, but we must look forward to another skilled individual working with us as we move forward."

And SouthGrow is indeed moving forward. The Water for Economic Development Project is now into its final stage of getting the news out there. "We've proven that southern Alberta is ready to grow and attract investment from a water availability and management perspective. Now, we need to let everybody know. We have a task to change some perceptions about whether investors can locate here due to the water resource - we need to assure them they can!" emphasizes Lagemaat.

The new Board is looking to renew the vision of SouthGrow Regional Initiative. "We continue to need to work cooperatively with all of our communities in the region. What is good for one of us ultimately is beneficial for all of us and we need to keep that in mind. Our goal is to enhance all of our member communities economically.
